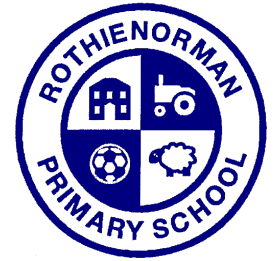

National Science Week

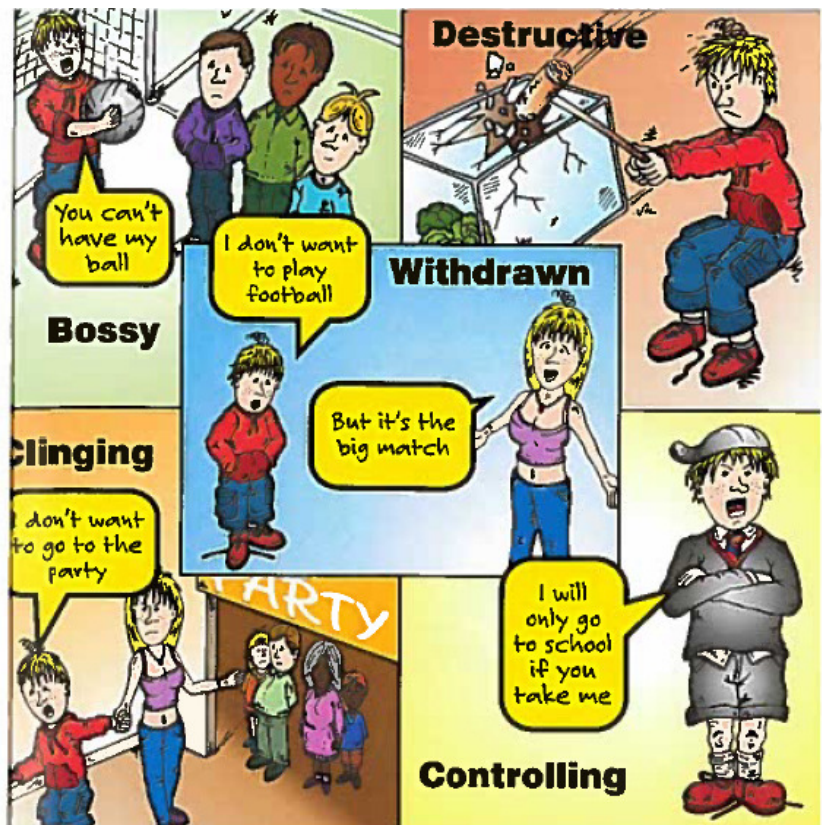
