# **COVID 19 Update**

The following advice is taken from the updated Scottish Government guidance published this week regarding testing and self-isolation. In summary, the guidance advises that if anyone in your household has symptoms, they should isolate and book a PCR test. Others in your household who are fully vaccinated (3 doses) or under 18 years and 4 months old do not need to isolate as long as they are returning daily negative LFD (Lateral Flow Device) tests. Anyone over the age of 18 years 4 months who is not fully vaccinated should book a PCR test and isolate for 10 days.

Regarding positive LFD tests, the updated advice is now that you are not advised to get a PCR to confirm infection but to follow isolation advice for positive tests.

The updated guidance on self-isolation is as follows: you are able to end self-isolation early if you return two consecutive negative LFD tests that are taken at least 24 hours apart with the first test being taken no earlier than day 6 if you are not displaying any fever.
