

## Dear Parent/Carer,

### Covid

There have been a number of positive cases of COVID reported to school recently. We are continuing to keep mitigations in place to reduce the spread of the virus. You can support this by keeping your child at home if they have any **symptoms** and then booking a PCR test as soon as possible. Parents can also support by giving **asymptomatic lateral flow tests** to pupils as this can reduce the likelihood of spread in schools by catching infections early. Please continue to contact the school if your child does receive a positive test.

## **Short-term Nursery Closure**

I'd like to express my sincere apologies to all who have been impacted by our recent nursery closure. I have been working with the Early Years team to try and avoid this situation, however for the safety of our pupils, we were unable to remain open on Tuesday 1st, Wednesday 2nd and Thursday 3rd of March.
