We have also introduced Zones of Regulation to support pupils develop their understanding of feelings and how to develop strategies to help manage these feelings.







Restorative Approaches and Emotion Coaching

This session we will be creating a Positive Relationships Policy as part of School Improvement Priority 3. This will be based on a relational approach built on developing mutual respect and positive relationships. Our approach will combine restorative approaches with emotion coaching, this enables us to view behaviour as a learning or emotional need and to respond to this need in a non-judgemental and empathetic manner to make sense of the behaviour and provide pupils with the tools to repair relationships.

I would be keen to share this approach with you, to explain the benefits of using a restorative approach and emotion coaching. I plan to hold an information session for parents this session. More information will follow.
