School Improvements

We are continuing to progress with our 3 school improvements for the session:

School improvement 1: Literacy

At the start of this term the team spent time auditing our reading books and donating some older books. This allowed us to see where the gaps are with in our range of books. We identified that there was a gap in non-fiction, particularly for the middle and upper stages. The PPG very kindly gave us funding to purchase books and these have been delivered and are in the process of being covered. You should start to see these soon S


Teaching staff have also been participating in peer observations in reading to ensure that there is a more consistent reading approach in the school and to ensure progression. Alongside this, they have also been engaging in training to support learning and teaching of writing.

School Improvement 2: Maths
